SERIES 10 CONTRIBUTIONS

§158-10-1. General.

- 1.1. Scope. -- These legislative rules establish guidelines concerning contributions for the WV Ethics Commission members and persons covered under the WV Governmental Ethics Act.
 - 1.2. Authority. -- W. Va. Code §§6B-2-1(a) and 6B-2-5(c)(4)
 - 1.3. Filing Date. -- April 29, 1992
 - 1.4. Effective Date. -- June 1, 1992

§158-10-2. Political Campaign Contributions.

Public officials and public employees may give or accept lawful political campaign contributions.

§158-10-3. Permitted Campaign Contributions.

- 3.1. Members of the Ethics Commission may contribute to a political campaign when the candidate or election committee for a candidate is required to publicly report and disclose the amount or type of contribution.
- 3.2. Members of the Ethics Commission who have contributed to a political candidate in any manner, shall recuse themselves from any official discussion or vote regarding the public official or candidate to whom the contribution was made.
- 3.3. Members of the Ethics Commission may not hold an office for a political candidate, such as a campaign manager or treasurer.
 - 3.4. Members of the Ethics Commission may not endorse any candidate.

§158-10-4. Ballot Issue.

West Virginia Ethics Commission members may not participate in a political campaign except to vote on or make political contributions relating to a ballot issue regarding:

- a. a bond issue
- b. a levy
- c. a referendum, or
- d. a constitutional amendment.
